This year, Southside Christian School found great success on the court. As all four teams, MS Girls, MS Boys, Varsity Girls, and Varsity Boys were all crowned Conference Champions!

Our MS Girls team coached by, Jennifer Thompson, was able to sweep the Conference with an 8-0 record highlighted with backto-back wins over Wilson Prep. Our Lady Warriors fought hard in the CAAC Conference and CAASC State Tournament but ultimately came up short.

The MS Boys team coached by, Mikel Simpson, also won the Conference with a 6-2 record. The season was highlighted with an early season win over CAAC opponent Southern Wake Academy. The Warriors earned a bid in both the Conference and State Tournaments this season.

Our Varsity Lady Warriors coached by, Danny Krauss, won the CAAC Conference with a 6-2 record. Their season was highlighted with a fifth place finish in the CAASC State Tournament, which is the farthest our Girls have ever advanced in State competition. The girls fought hard as they over came multiple injuries with only one substitute as the season came to a close. Senior Mekenzie Fairfield was selected as a first team All-Conference player and was nominated to play in the CAASC All-Star Game by coaches throughout the league.

The Varsity Boys team coached by CAAC Coach of the Year, Alex Dunn, also won the CAAC East Conference with a 6-2 record. The season was highlighted with a trip to the Conference Semi-Final match up verse Wilson Prep where the boys gave it their all but, came up short of a victory. Seniors Brandon Dunn and Daniel Krauss along with Junior Gabe Jewett were selected as members of the All-Conference first team and Junior Josh McLean received an Honorable Mention. Brandon and Daniel were both listed as Honorable Mentions on the All-State team and Gabe was nominated to participate in the CAASC All-Star game on March 10th.
