Each class is asked to send in the following items from the following categories for their shoeboxes. Sample items are listed:

- K4/3rd – clothing accessories – tops, shoes, socks, hair bows, gloves, scarves
- K5 – toys – deflated soccer ball with pump, dolls, etc.
- 1st – school supplies – chalkboards with chalk, pencils, scissors
- 2nd – clothing accessories – tops, shoes, socks, hair bows, gloves, scarves
- 3rd – toys – soccer ball with pump, dolls, etc.
- 4th – non-liquid hygiene items – bar soap, toothbrush, combs, brushes, washcloth, band-aids
- 5th – school supplies – chalkboards with chalk, pencils, scissors

Items that should NOT be included in your shoebox:

- Toothpaste
- used or damaged items
- war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures
- candy, gum, chocolate or food – due to customs regulations
- liquids or lotions – these can spill and get all over the other items
- medications or vitamins
- breakable items such as snowglobes or glass containers
- aerosol cans

Items can be brought to school beginning **Monday, October 15th**. All items will be collected until the day of packing and then Student Council will assist both campuses in sorting through the items and getting ready to assemble the boxes.
