Elementary Campus – Peanut Butter Substitutes

Please note that as of January 1, the Elementary Campus will no longer allow nut substitute spreads (i.e. Sunbutter, WOW butter, etc.) to be brought on campus. While we know that these products do not contain nuts, concern has been raised that nut products might be sent in accidentally.

In order to be certain that students with allergies are not at risk of exposure to nut products in the close environment at the Elementary campus, we are revising our policy to state that if a product smells like a nut, looks like a nut or nut spread, or spreads like peanut butter, it is not permitted on campus. Thank you for partnering with us to keep our little ones safe in our current campus setup.

Cold Weather Reminder

With the temperatures growing colder, we would like to take this opportunity to remind parents to dress their elementary children appropriate for the weather.

At the elementary campus, students will play outside for recess with temperatures in the 40's. Update Your RenWeb Information

Please take a moment to log into your RenWeb account to update your demographic and church information in our system. You may use the following steps to do this:

1. Go to www.factsmgt.com
2. Click on **Parent Log In**
3. Choose **FACTS Family Online (ParentsWeb)**
4. Enter your account information (District code, username, password)
5. Click **Login**
6. Once logged in, go to **School Information**
7. Click on **Web Forms**
8. Click on **Family Demographic Form**
9. Click on each of the different forms to update or add the information requested on each.
10. **PLEASE NOTE:** The Student Medical Form is NOT required and may be skipped.

FACTS/ParentsWeb Login Changes

RenWeb is now part of FACTS. You may have already noticed some changes when logging into ParentsWeb and FACTS. Since the FACTS and RenWeb systems are now integrated, you will only need to log into ParentsWeb in order to access both ParentsWeb and your FACTS accounts. Please see the following instructions for the new way to login to your ParentsWeb and FACTS accounts.

To access ParentsWeb and FACTS:

1. Go to www.factsmgt.com
2. Choose **Parent Login** at the top of the screen
3. From the drop-down, choose **FACTS Family Online (ParentsWeb)**
4. Use your former ParentsWeb login information to login to FACTS Family Online
5. Once in FACTS Family Online, you can click on **FACTS** at the bottom of the menu on the left-hand side. – From this screen, you may make payments to your account (including tuition and lunch charges) or access the FACTS Home screen to manage your FACTS account.
