School Information

Southside Christian School (SCS), accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and Cognia, was established in 2006 as a ministry of Southside Church. In 2018, SCS separated from Southside Church to become an independent school.

SCS currently offers honors classes in English, Social Studies, and Science. AP Calculus AB, AP Human Geography, AP Microeconomics, AP Pre-Calculus, and AP Computer Science Principles are being offered for the 2024-25 school year. Dual Enrollment credit is available during 11th and 12th grade.


