



Financial Information 2026-27

RETURNING STUDENTS: *Under the Continuous Enrollment Agreement, students are automatically enrolled for upcoming school years. A student's spot is secured when the enrollment fee is paid.*

- Enrollment for 2026-27: \$150 per student charged February 15, 2026 unless Withdrawal/Not Returning Form is submitted by February 5, 2026.
- Late Enrollment fee for 2026-27: \$200 per student charged March 1, 2026 if enrollment fee isn't paid by the end of February.

NEW STUDENTS:

- Application Fee: \$250/student (\$150 application fee + \$100 assessment fee)
- The Application Fee is required at the time of application.
- Registration/Enrollment Fee: \$575 per family, plus \$100/student
 - The Registration/Enrollment Fee is due within 7 days of receiving an emailed letter of acceptance.
 - This fee, along with the signed continuous enrollment contract, confirms your family's admission.

RESOURCE FEE: \$590/student

- The Resource Fee covers Textbooks & Workbooks, Student Support & Association Fees, Technology Integration, Curriculum Updates, and Supplemental Materials.

FACTS ANNUAL FEES:

- At time of enrollment, you will be required to set up an account with FACTS.
- \$25 annual fee/family to administer tuition payments
- \$55 annual fee required for tuition that is paid via a monthly payment plan

NSF FEES: A returned check or draft will result in a \$30 NSF fee per occurrence.

LATE FEES: \$30 will be assessed monthly if there is a balance due on your account and/or any payments were not paid by the due date.

FULL PAYMENT PLAN:

- *2% discount on full cost of tuition
- \$590 Resource Fee per student due at time of enrollment for upcoming school year
- Full payment must be received by May 1, 2026
- Payment must be made through FACTS

12 MONTH PLAN:

- Plan combines annual tuition with resource fee and is divided by 12 monthly installments
- The 1st installment is made May 5th or 20th
- All monthly tuition payments are made via required ACH draft through FACTS on the 5th or 20th of each month
- Plan runs May 2026-April 2027
- The first and second installments are non-refundable, should a student later withdraw, as this plan includes the resource fee in tuition installment
 - Students who withdraw after these months are responsible for payment of any fee amount not covered by the first two installments

WITHDRAWAL FEE: \$500 per student

- Students are considered enrolled for the entire school year; therefore, budgets and teacher contracts are set accordingly
- Students withdrawn after July 1st, 2026 will be assessed a \$500 withdrawal fee
- Students withdrawn after the first day of school may be responsible for tuition for the quarter in which withdrawn, in addition to the \$500 withdrawal fee

TUITION DUES:

- 25% due by the end of Quarter 1
- 50% due by the end of Quarter 2
- 75% due by the end of Quarter 3
- 100% due by the end of Quarter 4



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The fees listed below do not pertain to all students

BEFORE/AFTER CARE FEES PER STUDENT:

- \$50 Annual Registration Fee
- Before Care Daily Fee: \$5
- Aftercare Weekly Fee with pick up by 4:00 p.m.: \$45
- Aftercare Weekly Fee with pick up by 6:00 p.m.: \$80
- Aftercare Drop In Daily Fee with pick up by 4:00 p.m.: \$15
- Aftercare Drop In Daily Fee with pick up by 6:00 p.m.: \$30
- Additional minute charges will occur for students picked up after 6:00 p.m.
- Payments are due on the 20th of the month following the date of charges

LEARNING SUPPORT PROGRAM: The LSP program will provide small group, and in some cases, individualized learning support to students who have diagnosed learning needs. This program will carry an additional cost to families. Families will be asked to provide documentation of their child's learning needs (IEP or 504 Plan) during the admissions process to assure that the SCS LSP program can adequately support the student's education. The cost covers additional resources required for this support program. The ESA+ Program does, in some cases, cover the LSP fees and tuition.

Elementary Students

- \$2,200: Moderate Support (3 sessions/wk.)
- \$3,150: Intensive Support (5 sessions/ wk.)
- \$4,000: Intensive Support Plus (7 sessions/ wk.)
- \$1,200: Study Hall Sessions (2-3 times/wk.) for non-LSP Students

Middle School Students

- \$2,700: Moderate Support (3 sessions/wk.)
- \$4,250: Intensive Support (5 sessions/ wk.)
- \$5,250: Intensive Support Plus (7 sessions/ wk.)
- \$900: Additional Services (1 session/wk.)

High School Students

- Moderate Support (2 blocks/wk.): \$2,200

AP COURSE FEES: \$150 per AP course taken or proctored by SCS

- Covers the cost of AP exam, proctoring, and other expenses related to AP Courses
 - Non-refundable in the event a student decides not to take exam

SENIOR FEE: \$225 per senior

- Covers cap, gown, tassel and diploma
- Does not include class ring, graduation invitations, or senior trip
