### About SCS

Southside Christian School (SCS), accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International and Cognia, was established in 2006 as a ministry of Southside Church. In 2018, SCS separated from Southside Church to become an independent school.

SCS currently offers honors classes in English, Social Studies, Precalculus, Calculus, and Science. AP credits are available in Microeconomics, Calculus AB, Human Geography, Precalculus, Computer Science A and Computer Science Principles. Dual Enrollment credit is available in 11th and 12th grades.
